A permit to harvest up to 25 cubic metres (11 cords) to heat your home or shop is free. To get one, drop by your local Compliance Monitoring and Inspections office.


Remember to carry your permit with you when cutting and transporting wood. Harvesting trees without a permit or failure to comply with the terms and conditions could result in a fine of \$150.

If you choose to purchase firewood to support local businesses, please ensure you do so from an authorized vendor. The product should be labelled with a timbermark that confirms the harvesting was conducted legally.
