Justice Coordinator
Permanent Full-time

Qualifications:

Certificate or diploma in a social or justice related field, or equivalence in experience and relevant course work; Knowledge of Umbrella Final Agreement (UFA), Self-Government Agreement (SGA) and First Nations Final Agreement (FNFA); Knowledge of Territorial Court setting, protocols and routine; Knowledge of Territorial justice system and alternate methods for administration of justice such as Restorative Justice, Community Justice, traditional justice theories and models; **Valid Yukon Driver's License, class 4; Criminal Record Check; Ability to maintain a healthy lifestyle; Willingness to work flex time to accommodate weekend and evening tasks; First Aid and CPR.**

Duties: Reporting to Director of Health and Social Programs, this position is responsible for Planning, coordinating and delivering justice services for community members by:

- Informing those charged of: The nature and consequences of the charge(s) they are facing; Their rights, responsibilities and options under the law including alternative justice processes (if available); The philosophy and functioning of the Criminal Justice system, and of alternative justice processes (if available); Court procedures; The disposition or direction given by the court or community to the offender
- Providing the accused with appropriate referral to legal resources (as available and where practical)
- Identifying community service options and in liaison with the Probation Officer monitoring compliance
- Referring accused to appropriate social, education, employment, medical and other resources to enable them to address the underlying problems, which contribute to their charges and, where appropriate, follow-up on these referrals
- Liaising between the accused and Criminal Justice personnel to help overcome communication barriers and reduce cultural alienation from the Criminal Justice system. This may include being available to provide appropriate information to the court and/or speaking on behalf of the accused
- Informing justice officials about the cultural traditions, values, languages, socio-economic conditions, and other concerns of the LSCFN community and the cultural perspective of the alleged accused and initiate further understanding when required
- Promoting an understanding within the LSCFN community of the existing Criminal Justice system and alternative or community justice processes
- Promoting and facilitating practical, community-based justice initiatives and helping to build community capacity to identify and address justice related problems, which impact community members
- Participating in pre-circuit Court Conferences and preparing and ensuring a space is available for Court
- Coordinating and assisting in reintegration for those returning from Custody and or Parole in liaison with Victim Services providing support, encouragement, and referrals to support services as required for victims of crime
- Acting as a liaison with the RCMP on identifying prevention strategies needed such as collaborative crime prevention initiatives or when extra patrols are warranted due to grief, loss or other causal factors in the community
- Organizing along with other LSCFN Wellness staff crime prevention activities such as facilitating awareness sessions and organizing wellness circles, or healing camps
- Other related restorative justice duties
